ABSENCES AND MISSING WORK:

Many instructional methods are used that require student participation and if students are absent, they miss out on learning and experiences that enhance their intellectual growth. **Students with unexcused absences do not have to be given the opportunities to make up work, nor be given extensions on assignment due dates.** Consequences will therefore be directly reflected in the assessment/grades on missed or late assignments. Teachers may make accommodations, as they believe best for a student in a particular case, based on the learning goals for that course and student. **Teachers will offer a student with excused absences additional time (one day for each day excused) to complete the work and/or alternative work to meet the learning goals.** This does not excuse students from doing the work. **Ultimately it is the student's responsibility to follow up with the teacher after an excused absence.** (RCW 28A.600.030) In order to

receive “excused” status for an absence, a written note or telephone notification from the student’s parent/guardian must be filed with school personnel within two (2) school days following the student’s return to school.
